September 07, 2019: A young Dominican team finished the 2019 NORCECA Men's Continental Championship in Winnipeg, Canada, on a high note with a win over Guatemala.

The score was 3-1 (28-30, 25-13, 28-26, 25-19). The win puts the Dominican team in sixth place overall in the tournament.

Mario Emilio Frias led all scorers with 25 points, followed by Jonathon Mercedes with 23. Blocking was a factor for the Dominican side – 13 points compared with 7 for Guatemala.

Alexis Blanco had 21 points for the losing side while teammate Wagner Chacon had a tally of 17.

Dominican Republic, head coach, Jose Alexander Gutierrez:

“Our goal was to maintain our sixth position. We thought maybe we could do better as a bonus, but it wasn't possible. We look forward to more work ahead. This type of competition is very good for the young players – they grow up!”

Guatemala, player #17, Gerardo Paz:

“I'm a little disappointed in this match. We were able to get the first set, then I thought we could get the third for sure, but then we lost it. That brought us down.

It was still a good tournament for us. We played well and we're happy with that. Our goal was to beat the Dominican Republic, and we didn't achieve that, but we played really good against some higher level teams, such as United States and Cuba, and we're happy with that.

Next year Guatemala hosts the Central American Cup and we are looking forward to preparing for that.”





Canada wins bronze in front of home crowd

September 07, 2019: Canada won the bronze medal match over Mexico in a 3-0 (25-14, 25-18, 25-12) sweep today at the Men's 2019 NORCECA Continental Championships today in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada.

Ryan Sclater was the top individual contributor on the scoreboard with 17 points, followed by teammate Stephen Maar with 15.

Canada led in all aspects of the game, but the team's blocking was particularly effective – with 14 points compared with three for Mexico. Canada also led in service points – 6-1.

Ridl Alexis Garay was the only Mexican player to reach double digits with 10 points.

Canada will join Cuba, Mexico and Puerto Rico next January in the Continental Olympic Qualifier. The USA is the only NORCECA men's team to have locked up a Tokyo 2020 spot so far, winning its pool at the FIVB Qualifier in August.

Canada's head coach Glenn Hoag:

"With the exception of the second set, where we made too many unforced errors, I think the guys were really well focused. Our blocking has always been good, we want to improve on our defense and our consistency - we lose our focus sometimes, and start making mistakes. Now the challenge is for the guys to go to their clubs and stay healthy for January when we face Cuba, Mexico and Puerto Rico again."

Stephen Maar, player #7 Canada:

"It's great to play at home. We definitely found some weaknesses in our game, so that will be important to work on, and we'd rather figure those things out now than in January. We feel good – our job was to qualify, we tried to beat Cuba yesterday, but what really matters is in January."

Overall, we blocked really well and served at times quiet well. But we made mistakes and now we can take away the lessons from here and move forward."

Mexico head coach, Jorge Miguel Azair Lopez:



“We didn’t play as well as what we are used to, but it’s time to turn the page and focus on the next tournament for us, which is the Olympic qualifier. Now the different players go to their professional leagues in Europe and other places, so it will be a challenge to prepare, but we will do our best.”



Cuba is golden at the Men's NORCECA Championship

September 07, 2019: Cuba won the gold-medal match 3-1 (25-18, 21-25, 25-20, 25-20) at the 2019 Men's NORCECA Continental Championship at the University of Winnipeg in Manitoba, Canada.

Cuba led in attack points (46-34), and dominated from the service line (10-5), but the U.S. held its own in blocking with 11 points compared with Cuba's seven.

Cuba's was a team effort with Osniel Mergarejo and Miguel Angel Lopez leading scoring with 15 each, followed by Robertlandy Simon (including four aces) with 14 and Marlon Yant with 12.

TJ Deflaco and Kyle Ensing had 12 points apiece for the United States.

Cuba had already locked up a spot in the NORCECA Olympic Qualifier next January as the winner of the recent Champions Cup, held in Colorado Springs, Colorado. The U.S. is already qualified for the 2020 Olympics as winner of its pool in the FIVB Qualification Tournament last month.

Cuba, head coach, Yosvany Muñoz Perez:

"I'm very happy. We came here to fight for first place, and that happened. We had very strong serves, the reception was very, very good and our attacking was a good performance.

Our players now will play professionally all over the world and we'll get back together in December to prepare for the Olympic Qualification tournament. "

USA, head coach, John Hawks:

"They served really well, as we expected, and I think offensively they were just a little sharper than they were the other night (when USA won in the pool match). We didn't pass as well as we did, we lost the serve/pass game.... Our guys are trying to prove ourselves to our senior teams, to be on the roster....

Leaving here with the silver medal is great, but we want gold. We're proud of the effort, but in the end we just weren't sharp enough, so credit to Cuba, they played great."
